Construction Update.

The restrooms, plumbing, electrical work, and constructing the bar have been the slowest parts of the process, but the light is finally shining at the end of the tunnel. Once the Social Quarters is complete, the kitchen will become our next focus. There is still a lot of cleanup needed throughout the building, along with smaller tasks such as touch-up painting and other finishing details.

The biggest challenge has been funding. We are maintaining, but we need to be conscientious about spending in order to keep up with regular bills.

Financial Update

As discussed and voted on at the Special Meeting on December 23rd, a dispensation request was submitted to Moose International to allow us to obtain a mortgage against the building to offset the costs of rebuilding our lodge home. After submitting the required documentation, the dispensation was approved, and United Southern Bank is moving forward with the application. The next step is an appraisal, which is expected to be completed in about two weeks. The wheels are slowly turning, and Golden Triangle is rising from the embers!

Moose International provided a \$10,000 grant which was used to cover the cost of flooring. The Florida Moose Association provided a \$15,000 grant to cover ongoing expenses. The Moose is not in the financial business, their mission and focus are the children at Mooseheart and our seniors at Moosehaven. So a huge thank you to both Moose International and Florida Moose Association for their consideration and help in this time of need.

Currently, we are at approximately \$80,000 in expenses, with about \$30,000 already paid. An audit is in progress, and the results, along with actual figures, will be presented at a General Lodge Meeting in the near future. These numbers are estimates but give a sense of the scale of costs encountered so far.
